WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT

On July 1, 2000, the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998 was implemented in Georgia. WIA aims to improve the quality of the workforce, enhance the productivity and competitiveness of the nation, and reduce welfare dependency.

WIA also created One-Stops to provide to the citizens of each county the ability to find, a comprehensive center or access point that contains all the technology, resources, people, and information necessary for customers to receive job listing information and to have their career needs met.



In accordance with the recently implemented Workforce Investment Act, Coastal Workforce Services works closely with local elected officials, the Coastal Workforce Investment Board, and partner agencies to provide leadership and guidance in workforce development for the nine-county Coastal region.

The three population segments served under the Workforce Investment Act are Adults, Dislocated Workers, and Youth.
